

STAFF COMMUNICATION SEASON-TO-SEASON



WEEK AFTER SEASON END: GRATITUDE/INVITATION

Within 7-10 days of the camp season ending, send out a brief message of gratitude that highlights their accomplishments over the last camp season. Data like total number of campers served, camper feedback, or setting a new record can be helpful. Be sure to end this quick message with an invitation and pathway for continued feedback as well as to consider returning for the next camp season.



AUG/SEPT: COMPENTENCIES/ENCOURAGEMENT

Many of your staff will return to formalized education sometime during August or September. This is a great time to reach out with a brief note of encouragement. Consider providing them with a list of competencies from camp that they can use to apply for work. An inside joke or insight from the camp season is always welcome.

NOV/DEC: SEASON REGISTRATION LAUNCH

You're already telling campers and parents that registration for the upcoming season is now open, why not announce to your staff as well? Keeping them in the loop helps the feel included and can nurture the thought of returning for another season. Consider including your recruiting/hiring schedule. Even a team member who isn't planning to return might pass it along to a new candidate.

JAN/FEB: STAFF APPLICATION LAUNCH

It's already time to hire for the next season. Send out a quick message to last year's team asking them to consider returning for another season. If they can't or don't want to return, that's okay - ask them to consider recommending your camp to someone they know or recommending someone they know to you. Linking to an online application process makes applying quick and easy.

APR/MAY: STAFF WELCOME & PREVIEW

The next season is almost here. Send out a quick message to your new team that includes a warm welcome and key information to help them feel prepared and confident upon arrival. Resist the urge to share mountains of info - they are still in class. Just the basics and a way to reach out for more if desired.
